




This book is designed to give understanding and insight into the various throws and Games given in Divinity Dice and the Decimal Dice series of publications..

Divinity Dice reawakens an ancient system that uses the Platonic Solids as well as the Ten Sided Dice. This book gives you the interpretations for Aspects derived from the techniques and games in both the Divinity Dice and Decimal Dice Workbooks.

The writers wishes to stress to the reader, however, that no system of divination will solve your problems for you. When a King went to the Oracle at Delphi he asked "Will I win a war against my neighbour?" The Oracle answered, "When a river is crossed the great king will fall."

The King presumed this meant that when he crossed the river that was the boundary between him and the opposing King, that the oracle said he would win. However, as it worked out, HE was the great King who fell.

This is the nature of Divination. You will read into things according to your state of consciousness You will paint the meaning for the answers you get into the framework of your personal understanding. And this is how it is meant to be.

We do not want to give you answers, but offer you a path for you to discover your own answers. Like the moon shines on the lake, and tells you the direction to the Moon, we simply suggest the direction. You have to find a Ladder that will get you to the Moon, or whatever your dreams may be.

All who profess to be able to tell you the future have not looked at the truth, which is that YOUR future comes from within you, and from nowhere else. Are you Telling Forth, or foretelling? Are you finding the resource inside you, or looking for a crutch to help you through your present moment?

And the real paradox is that, either way, YOU decide.



INTRODUCTION To The Book of Aspects

Welcome to the *Book of Interpretations for the Divinity Dice*. Here you will find all the meanings for the aspects derived from the Techniques used in the *Decimal Dice*, and *Divinity Dice Instruction Books*.

All interpretations are derived from the Pythagorean Teachings about the Patterns within Number. These teachings started with the philosopher, Pythagoras, who lived in the Golden Age of Greece. From 500BC to 600AD, the Pythagorean University movement that was at the heart of the then civilized world.

A Temple to Pythagoras was discovered (still extant) in 1991 during excavations in Rome. This was closed down in 600 AD on the then orders of the Roman Emperor Justinian (Who had decreed all pagan teachings were to be abolished).

Relevant signs and patterns in the tessellation of tiles used in this temple revealed much. From this many of the old secrets were resolved, and as a result these were compiled into a new course in the Pythagorean system of Number in that same year.

What emerged that was new and different from the correspondence course was the information of the Pythagorean Trines, and the Pythagorean Patterns as related to the Matrix.

The pattern of the Matrix is an ancient "map" of Decimal Number that has been used down the countless millennia. It is the pattern used in the Game Tic Tac Toe today. Pythagoras adapted its use to his new mathematics, based on the Vedic system from what we can understand, and there is definite evidence that the Matrix pattern was used by Solomon.

The Romans and the Greeks used the pattern of the Matrix in board games, and this small "Chessboard" of Nine Squares was a used in many cultures for a variety of purposes.

We do not go into this in this series of books, but there is a pat-

tern of Number to be found by breaking down any given date into the essential cycles within it. This "identifies" a given day with a number sequence that is highly relevant to anyone who fully understands the Pythagorean System of Number Analysis.

Finding Universal Patterns

What emerges is a universal set of patterns that unlocks the inner workings of the Human Psychology. Based on the Pythagorean Precept that "All is Number" we adjusted the traditional methods to a more easily assimilated form. Like Cheiro in the 1930's and his books on Palmistry, we adapted ancient knowledge to a form that anyone could grasp.

In the Divinity Dice series of books we currently have Divinity Dice (using the Platonic Solids) and Decimal Dice. (using the 10 sided Dice) In both we give you an enormous range of "games" or techniques where we apply the random throws of Polyhedral Dice to understand any given question we might have.


People continue to be astonished with the extraordinary accuracy of the answers they get from the various readings described in the Divinity and Decimal Dice Workbooks

Igniting the Divine Flame

The purpose of *Divinity Dice* is a passing on of the *Divine Spark*. The purpose of this is to ignite the *Fire of Truth*, the *Thoth*, within you. This is what sets us free from the illusions of our own creation. So, taking this allegory, let's take a brief look at the discovery of *Fire*, to help us see with different eyes the meaning and purpose of *Fire and Truth*.

Before the discovery of *Fire*, before language progressed beyond grunts and physical directions, man wandered the planet as hunter gatherers. Unlike many of our brothers, the Apes, we were happy to be omnivorous.

Eating raw flesh may not be the biggest thing in culinary arts today, but in human prehistory it was a pretty good thing to do. What is more important is that this meant that the Human species could survive in just about any climate.

Then, a lightning strike (we would presume) started a forest fire. The Humans escaped for heat and flames, but coming back to find the body of loved ones, some bright spark sees how an animal that was normally eaten raw is now cooked.

This brave Soul decided to see what it tastes like, and lo and behold, it tastes GREAT. He or she figures that the fire was what did this, and cleverly gets a bit of ember remaining from the fire, and re-creates fire with sticks and twigs. This is the first stove. Shortly after this the Art of Cooking is invented, and the sink and the toaster come soon after.

Looking at this evolution more seriously, the above scenario is simply a guess, but we can imagine the power and amazement the discovery of *Fire* created. In the book, "Clan of the Cave Bear" we can read a wonderful description of the events and thoughts surrounding this discovery.

How does this fit in with *Divinity Dice*, and the casting of Numbers to predict future and present patterns and events?

Alongside the discovery of Fire came the start of religion and the Mystical Teachings. This is not "religion" as we know it today,

Before *Fire*, people were individualists. Hunters hunted, non-hunters gathered, and all ate food according to their tribal ranking. Together everyone survived the environment. But when *Fire* came along, a whole new hierarchical order came into being.

First and foremost, and blindingly obvious, people now stayed up late. Essentially, *Fire* EXTENDED the operating hours of the Human Race, thus fire gave us more TIME. This meant that the evening hours became a social gathering, and the first thing that happened was that people, possibly for the first time, were beyond survivalist mentality. Now we wanted to entertain and be entertained. We wanted to TALK.

This created the need for a more concise language. Prior to fire, it was all the reading of emotions by expression and feeling the "vibe" in the air. After *Fire* it changed and people had to be able to express themselves in *Firelight*. You could not read the expression so easily on someone's face, so you had to articulate with vocal sounds and gesture more clearly.

Let us not underestimate the power of Speech. It is THE pivotal point that (apart from the opposing thumb) truly distinguishes us from the Apes and allows the creation of civilization.

Dice and Gaming have been a condition of Western Life since the earliest recorded history.

For thousands of years people have associated the chance throw of the Dice with the Will of the Gods.

The Pythagoreans called the Platonic Solids the "Dice of the Gods" and gave divine truths to random throws of these when created as Dice



We need to remember that the gathering of a tribe around a fire was a sacred event like no other. It was the Church of the day. After the hard work of survival, the evening Fire represented the time you came together to invoke the greater being-ness of the Tribe. People had this time to contemplate the meaning and significance of what they saw through their day.

Let us remember that until recent times, God was always a part of the natural world. Discussion of the days events would quite naturally fall to the divine guidance, or the spiritual events that caused the Hunter to go that way and get the Mammoth, etc.

In our culture, this guidance or native intuition is given names such as "God" and the "Divine". And it is still very much active in the lives of many people. Talk to any musician in a band that really works, and they will tell you the same story. Something steers you to go this particular way with the music, and it just works. Most do not recognize "it" in their daily life, but in primitive societies "IT" was an energy that all could feel and see.

The Pythagoreans call this "energy" the "Music of the Spheres". Even now, we can still tune into this primordial sound and light current, to hear and see the core language between Man and the Divine. It simply takes effort, and an inner awareness of the Divine in your life. This "Core" language has a tonal language of Vowels. And would you believe, there are 12 universal vowel sounds, each having an accordance with the Tones of Music.

People heard these Vowel tones, and wrapped language around it. The vowel is ALL cultures is the basis of language, and this is not just chance. The Ancient Greeks called the Sound Current the "E" for example, and every sacred scripture throughout the world refers to the Sound and light currents in their texts.

Back to the meeting around the campfire each evening. This gave time for people to contemplate as a community, and share the thoughts. This meant that rather than tripping off into a personal world, each individual had to find a way to communicate.

This "Fire Time" allowed this communication to grow, and in a sense, forced it. No one likes to sit and say nothing for hours on end... And so the journey started with the creation of language

and in the process the savage began the journey to civilization through this use of language.

People came to the Creation of Language because of the combination of the sound of the Divine Sound Current, the nightly gathering at the Fire, and the natural need to communicate.

Before this can fully be understood, we need to grasp that we are not "just" the body. We are a Divine Spark, a wearing a body, and by tuning into this Sound and Light current, we re-awaken out connection back to our own divine source. IT is intelligent, and IT guides all who allow it.


The discovery of Fire gave rise to Society. Prior to Fire, it was all survival. Fight the beasts, find a safe place to sleep, and then fight for supremacy politically and socially within the tribe. With Society came rules and leaders to enforce them. Here we find a new class emerged, the storytellers These are the ones who ruled the Mind and Imagination of the tribe, and this was where the first religion began.

Fire created new levels in Society and started a huge number of power plays, setting into motion powerful passions. Competition is a natural instinct in Man, it defines him as being separate from another, therefore more respected, etc. in the eyes of peers. Great acts of bravery and courage became hallmarks of your worth, the stamp that told the tribe you were important.

But with the fire and all that spare time around the campfire one thing would elevate you as much as performing great deeds, and this was TELLING of the great deeds The power to tell a story became a force to be reckoned with. The power of the story united the tribe, gave them common purpose, taught the youth and became the glue that held society together.

The Story of the hunt grew to the story of the tribe, which grew to the story of the nation, which became the Myths and beliefs of the people. Here, knowledge could be handed down from generation to generation, and the teller of the story was given a special place in the hearts of the people.

And eventually, one fo the greatest powers of all was invented, the WRITTEN language.



What this meant was that the writer of the tale, the recorder of the wisdom was able to contain History and Truth for all. EG: The story teller called Homer (not Simpson) wrote of tales that spanned thousands of years and his story still teaches people the basic precepts of life.

At the campfire, the storyteller was the one who was prized. This was the person who would take people away from the pain and suffering of the day, and bring them to the brave new world within the IMAGINATION. Imagination was fanned, and this is the Divine Spark within man finally catching to flame with the written word..

Yet opposing this light a darkness emerged. At the same time we find around the campfire the beginning of politics. This was another form of storytelling. One leader invariably opposed another leader. People petty enmities would reveal themselves more clearly in the quiet of the evening, and you would see those who opposed each other sit opposite around the fire.

As much as we can imagine reverence and even worship of the Fire, or at least, the Divinity within that made the Fire possible, we also know that the nature of the Human is to quarrel and fight for dominance. But we tend to do so as a group animal, not as an individual.

So the would be leaders gather supporters, each facing each other off every night until the camp fire became a meeting of opposites. Finally in some battle one leader would triumph over the other, and he would take an elevated position so he could survey the potential opposition at the next campfire. People do this to mark their authority. Thus the first "thone" was created, and the first steps towards royalty had begun.

Any who would not agree to the rule of the One would have to move on or suffer consequences. So we now find that Fire also accents the politics of leadership. Those who were once too busy through the day to argue were now forced to face each other each night in potential confrontation.

What happened next is still what happens today. In the midst of

the new world of Fire and politics there emerged a different class of Human, the *spiritual traveler*, the one who journeyed to the higher worlds. Rather than seeking power, these few looked to discover truth, and fewer still looked for a greater love.

These were individuals who lived for the God Inspired state. They looked for and received the deeper messages from Spirit. Now far from a romantic notion, this became useful to the tribe, because there folk became the healers, and also the ones who could say the best place to spend the winter.

But if the Diviners message was to be heard by all, these folk could not be seen to be connected to the tribal power struggles. These folk who preferred the spiritual quest could not be seen to sit with any opposing camps. To be effective, the spiritual being had to be non-involved in the politics and passions of the tribe.

And so a separate race, the ones who would become the priests, began to evolve. These are the "Witch Doctors" who shook spears and feathers and danced to cure ills, and who read the omens. In time, these people came to see themselves as an elite, and developed their own power base.

In many cultures, the priests evolved to control society more surely than the leaders of the tribes. Fear of the invisible realms is a powerful force to hold over the head of a superstitious soul.

The competing politics of the tribe caused the separation of the tribes, and with the first move towards separation the new leader's first task would be to obtain Fire. Naturally, they would have taken off with a spark of the original fire, which also means that the existing leader would guard this flame day and night.

This created the "Versus" mindset. This attitude of opposition spawned the reality of separation, and so the various tribes began to filter outwards, into family groups and tribal affinities, spreading across the lands.

Naturally in the expansion of the tribes, arguments over territory would emerge, and thus the first stages towards the setting of boundaries began. War started as a matter of settling disputes, but it also came about through the desire for another's lands.



In all of this, the priests were establishing their own territory, the territory of the mind. The storyteller were also establishing a territory, that of the observer on the fringe. The clown and the Jester came from this tradition, and even to this day we see the politicians, the storytellers and the priests in their own set groups.

But above and beyond all of these another group began to emerge. **These were the creative sparks.** These came out of every section of society. In the storytellers, they created the new songs and tales. In the Tribes, these were the communicators. With the priests, these were the ones who recorded and built up the Language and symbols of the divine... Among these were the Scribes, the artists, the dreamers and the seers.

The scribes in Ancient Egypt took on a very powerful role. They stood aside from the priests and the Pharaoh and these were the ones who recorded the utterances of the Divine Seers that became the Egyptian Book of Dreams and the Egyptian Book of the Dead.

In modern times, these books and the Pyramid texts became some of the first references to a spirituality beyond the physical and a record of paths into the other worlds an individual might make when they left their body. It is also clear now, according to the Astrological evidence in the Pyramid texts, that these scriptures are at least 12,500 years old. Only the Nacaal Writing preceded these texts in antiquity.

This all seems a long way from the Discovery of Fire, but even in the Egyptian texts, the Lord of Fire, Thoth, was the divine intelligence. The greatest of all things to uncover within yourself was the Intelligence of the Heart, of the Knowing Fire of the Heart.

In all of this, the Discovery of Fire was the instigator of the spiritual truths being recorded and so they were passed down from generation to generation. Now, finally, it comes back to you.

All the Interpretations within this book come from an Ancient Lineage. The principles of Number existed in practical form before man worked out the language of the stars or the omens of the woodland creatures and nature. The most illiterate savage knew the difference between one elephant and three elephants,

and the association of Number to external events was one of the most primary spiritual truths that was common to all races, and all tribes.

In the most ancient of cave drawings (now proven via infra-red and ultra-violet analysis to be far older and far more complex than previously recognized) we see clear messages of Number and the association with the Divine.

The Logic of Number is inherent in all living things. One things begets the next. A specific state leads to the next state, and so on. One and One equals two. What the Ancients have done, and which is passed onto you here and now, is to ascribe the Language of the Divine as it flows through the occurrence of Number in your life. Believe, or disbelieve, nothing will change. Accept this wisdom, shape your life accordingly, and things will change.

In whatever you choose to do with the information given freely in this book, know that in the writing and the transference of this wisdom and knowledge that we are passing over to you a spark of the Divine Flame and entrusting it to you. Below are the words of the Pythagorean Initiation, which we ask you to read..

In order for it to burn brightly, you need to know that knowledge is not wisdom, and wisdom is not virtue. From the position of choice comes the right to choose, and we trust that in time your way will be made clear, and this torch that we hand to you now will in turn be passed along to others in time.
