

BOOK ONE: *Let the Dice Fly High*

This introductory section is a booklet of Games, and with all games, there are rules. The first rule is, there are hardly any rules!

All this entails is simply adding things up and making sense out of what answers come to you. This is a series of games where you follow a pattern, and it leads you to an answer. Let your INTUITION guide you. Of course: The more you practice, the better your intuition will become.

How it Works: Ask a question, throw the Dice according to the games we show you here, and you get these amazing and interesting interpretations. But it doesn't stop there... Getting an Interpretation is the start, now YOU have to figure out how this connects to the question.

When you put the Question alongside the Interpretation, you find lots of options start opening up, and many answers seem to come your way. So now you may need to re-qualify the question, and throw the Dice again! Try a different Game, and see what comes of it.

That's how it works. It can also be great fun to have a group of people all putting in their view. Dice Satsang it is called... Satsang simply means "Gathering".

The one detail you will have to understand is a thing called SIMPLE ARITHMETIC. You may throw the 10 Sided Dice three times and get the numbers: 9, 5, 8. Add these together, to get 22. THEN we can add the 22 DOWN to get 4. ($2+2 = 4$) This is, as it says, arithmetic that is simple. Just add down the numbers you add up.

The rest is simply following the "form" or technique we show you, finding the Interpretations, and working it out from there.






Let's Practice Throwing the Dice: 6 Box Technique

We all want instant answers to our questions, and this is a great way to start. This is the 6 Box Technique. The way it works is simple. First: ASK A QUESTION. Let's invent a question. It could be anything: Does that Girl fancy me? Will I get that new job? Etc.

A Quick Focus on the Question:
 Maybe you are asking "How does this new promotion look?" Finding the right question is the hard part. You are not "really" wanting to know how a promotion LOOKS are you? You are wanting to know if it is a step in the right direction, if you will enjoy the new challenges, if it will be worthwhile, etc.

So STOP and focus on the question first. Qualify it. "Does this new promotion enhance my career?" is a better question ... but what is "your career"? Get it? We are looking for the HEART of the Question you want to know. Underneath it all, what you need to know what your direction is in this present moment, and it happens to be a job that is staring you in the face that is the main concern.



After the finding question, the rest is easy. Draw a series of boxes like those in the top graphic. The meaning for these is over the page.

Next we throw the 10 Sided Dice THREE times. Let's say you throw a 4, 9 and 5... write these numbers into the three boxes. (The second diagram) . So far, so good... Now we simply add the numbers together in the way we show you..

We add the 4 and 9 to get 13 and write it into the box under and between their "place" Likewise we add the 9 and the 5 to get 14 and place this addition in the box allocated. Now we add the 13 and the 14 together, to get the Final Addition of 27. We see all the additions in the above graphics. Could it be any simpler? Now comes the tricky part.



Your additions equal the three aspects of Past, Future and Present. Now we have to place the answers we get in each area in the context of the question asked, which is “What is my life path?”. Now when we look at things, it will make simple and immediate sense.

The 13 represents the PAST, the 14 represents the FUTURE and the 27 represents the PRESENT. You asked about a new job, now look up the interpretations.

PAST: 13... You may be greatly misunderstood. Even so, this is not at all unlucky and indicates a new energy arriving in your life.

FUTURE: 14... Snakes and Ladders: A number of movement, travel and new associations.

PRESENT: 27... Reward will come from the application of intellect, not physical force. Growing the Intelligence of the Heart will bring the greatest of rewards.



So, you asked about where you are at the moment. You threw the Dice and you got these interpretations. Can you make any sense out of it? The first response is often “Hell, this looks complicated!”. But really, it isn't.

In the Past, concerning the direction you have taken, you have been misunderstood. Maybe you didn't understand yourself, or someone else has been the issue? Even so, it is not unlucky, and from the PAST a new energy is coming. So, the message is: Look for someone or something from your PAST. Get it?

The FUTURE says “Movement, Travel, New Associations” Does this new promotion offer this? If it doesn't, it does not fit into your future direction, so maybe you need to look further.

The PRESENT says to apply intellect, not force. You can't push things at the moment. Do you need more education? If you are in a physical job, it may be saying “get out of this field”. It also speaks of growing the Intelligence of the Heart. Huh?



6 Box Technique: *Continued*

What does “Grow the intelligence of the Heart” mean? Well, that is something for you to consider. It was considered the highest of all attributes in Ancient Egypt. IE: To be able to see clearly with the heart.

So far, your reading is saying that if the promotion involves travel, new people and movement, it is a good thing to go for. It is also saying that you will get to this “future” possibility through the use of Intelligence, not force. This could be saying it is a “Who you know” position that is coming up, and you better start working the connections if you want the job. Getting the idea of how it works?

You are given the pieces to the Jigsaw puzzle, but you have to find the way the pieces fit together best. And you may have to give it a few throws until you start to get the message.

All the interpretations for every number between 1 and 60 are at Page 36 of this booklet. Practice this simple Game, because it really works.

You can take this game one step further. Add up ALL the Past, Present and Future numbers to get an overall number. In this case $14 + 13 + 27 = 54$. Look up 54 in the Composite Numbers, and we get: **54... Reaching the Stars requires letting go of the Earth.** Get it? You have to let go of your fears, and just get on with it.

Now, sometimes the additions of Past, Future, and Present come to over the number 60. If you threw 9, 9 and 9 you would get additions of $18 + 18 + 36 = 72$. Simple: Add the 72 to get $(7+2 = 9)$ NINE.

That’s it! That is all there is to the Six Box Game. You can play this at parties, and all you need is this little book, your 10 sided dice, and some interested people. The real trick, as we mentioned, is to get the RIGHT QUESTION. Asking the Right question is like opening the right door. Some basic considerations for you may be:

- Career: What is it that you “really” want? Are you looking for purpose, money, prestige, security or just to get by because you have other interests?
- Love: Are you looking for Love, or Sex? Are you wanting a long term faithful relationship, or something exciting?
- Finance: Are you prepared to go out on a limb? Are you willing to risk everything on a toss of the coin? What are your limits?

Play this game, and get to know the “real” you a whole lot more!



6 Box Technique: Continued

OK... Final Page of the Six Box technique. The process so far is:

1. *We throw the 10 sided dice three times*
2. *We write down the numbers, and add them up*
3. *We look up the interpretations, and finally*
4. *We try to make some sense out of it all.*

The key to getting good answers is asking the right questions. Often we have to throw the Dice several times, and the Dice themselves often offer interpretations that will lead you to ask better questions.

It's all a "go with the Flow" thing. Trust your instincts, and work out what it really is that you want to know. *A perfect example came from a tarot card reader I knew. A fellow came in to the reader asking if he was going to become a world famous writer. The reader saw it was really a fellow who just wanted to escape the public service, so he urged him to qualify his question.*

"Why not ask if you are going to become famous, or more to the point ask if you are going to become a GOOD writer. I know for a fact there are only a handful of famous writers on the planet, so maybe we need to focus on what do you REALLY want to know?"

The fellow said, flatly, that he wanted to know if he was to become a famous writer. Nothing else would do. So the tarot card reader laid out the cards, and told him he would marry a nice girl, have three children and be quite happy in this life.

I asked him later, "What did the cards REALLY say to his question. "Oh," he answered, "they clearly suggested he may well be a famous writer. "Well ... Why didn't you tell him?" I asked. His answer always stayed with me to this very day. "Now now, if I told him he was really going to be a famous writer, he may go do something really foolish and leave his job. If he is going to be what he is going to be, it surely doesn't need a mere tarot card reader like me to set him straight!"

That's the real truth. No matter what comes up, the future is really in YOUR hands. The dice may offer you clues as to the Frame of your Destiny, but YOU are the one who chooses what picture to hang in it.

Relax, have fun, and don't take it too seriously. You will be amazed at the uncanny accuracy of the readings, but take it easy because your journey of Dice Divination has just begun.



Finding Doublets in the Matrix: 9 Box Technique

Below we see the traditional Number Positions for the Pythagorean Matrix. It is quite simple; the lower left box is the starting point, and the upper Right Box is the end. You write down your throw of the dice according the order in which it is thrown

Each throw of the Dice places a number “over” the top of the pre-existing position. Below we show you the basic idea. Again, we are using the 10 Sided Dice. We throw this Dice TEN TIMES, and place the numbers thrown in the traditional order, as shown in “Nine Boxes” to your left. The graphic is self explanatory. You throw the numbers (in this order): 3, 7, 9, 0, 1, 2, 6, 1 and 1

Now we **COMBINE** the throw with the pre-ordained Number Position. It gives us a combination of Double Numbers that combines the ORDER of the throw, with the throw itself

3/9 6/2 9/1
 2/7 5/1 8/1
 1/3 4/0 7/6

3 \ 9	6 \ 2	9 \ 1
2 \ 7	5 \ 1	8 \ 1
1 \ 3	4 \ 0	7 \ 6

NOTE: the FORTH casting of the Dice gives 4/0. Consider this a “blank” for now. We will not go into the significance of this here.

We now have a PATTERN OF NUMBER to work with. Always try to remember, when we are working with the Dice, we are looking for a Pattern of Number that relates to one or more of the interpretations.

The Next stage is to simple look up the meanings of these, and with your question in mind, see what picture forms out of it. (over)



9 Box Technique: Continued

Interpretation for the throw 3, 7, 9, 0, 1, 2, 6, 1 and 1 is as follows:

- 1/3 Big plans, but often insecure
- 2/7 Balance the Masculine and Feminine within
- 3/9 Take care with appearing pretentious
- 4/0 (Zero Dice casting. Has significance, but too detailed for here)
- 5/1 Ego whispers the most cunning truth
- 6/2 Can you see yourself in the mirror
- 7/6 Get over the hump and the new day awaits
- 8/1 Throw caution to the wind carefully
- 9/1 Knowing what to say is half the battle

It is amazing how clearly a message is formed. Just by reading through the interpretations, the concepts in regards an answer to your question starts to form.

Imagine if your question was about Travel to India this year. You can see easily how a message will form through the INTERACTION of the interpretation with the question. See what the Dice say to you with the Travel question then, for practice, change the question.

Now imagine you are asking about your current relationship. Can you see how the above "interpretation" will adjust and give new insights into this area as well? A whole set of different aspects will highlight themselves. This is what makes this technique so good at parties.

Can you see that with this combination of throws there are three ONE's in the position of the 5, 8 and 9? This forms a TRINE which also has a meaning. (We take this up later in Advanced Games)

In summary, getting clear results from ALL Divinity Dice techniques comes down to the Question you ask. More specifically, it all hinges on the sort of questions you are asking. Try it... Ask a question, throw the dice, and see what comes of it. Remember: ASK YOUR QUESTION FIRST. Preferably, take a sheet of paper, and write the question down on the sheet of paper you will work with.

Work out your Matrix Map, throw the 10 sided dice Nine Times and write down the numbers in order of their appearance in the boxes as we have discussed. That's it for the Double Number Technique.

Just this process on its own is enough to solve many concerns.



9 Box Technique: Continued

Let's look at this again. We have the basic Graphic as shown to the right.

We throw the Dice NINE TIMES in order to find a number to match against the "original" number. This gives us the Double Number, or Doublet.

3	6	9
2	5	8
1	4	7

We look up the Double Number and see what the flow of interpretations adds up when we compare it against the question we have in mind. Could it be any simpler?

3 / 6	6 / 3	9 / 6
2 / 2	5 / 6	8 / 4
1 / 2	4 / 0	7 / 7

Let's look at another example. First, and as always, we ASK A QUESTION. We throw the 10 Sided Dice nine times, and we come up with the following Numbers: 2, 2, 6, 0, 6, 3, 7, 4 and 6. We write these into the Pattern to our Right against the "original" number positions to get the graph as shown.

This gives us the Double Numbers of: 1/2, 2/2, 3/6, 4./0, 5/6, 6/3, 7/7, 8/4 and 9/6 which we now look up in the Double Number Interpretations on pages 22 to 23. These are as follows:

- 1/2 Creative, often indecisive you ask what to do**
- 2/2 Time to Decide**
- 3/6 Mind your Mind, Care for the Heart**
- 4/0 No specific Meaning**
- 5/6 Your Path is clear now, Decide**
- 6/3 Thinking is good when it serves a purpose**
- 7/7 Risk is called for. Look to Act**
- 8/4 Power must be matched with compassion**
- 9/6 Careful consideration is called for**

Obviously, the Die is saying it is time to decide, and that there is a risk. However, consideration of the heart of things, both for self and for others, will pay dividends. Not so hard, is it?
